

TIRE CHOICE

- Find a pattern as per your driving conditions
- Do not fit different sizes on the same axis.
- Only mount size, which have been specified by the manufacturer.

• TIRE ROTATION

- To maximize the tire performance, you should
- Make axis rotation, every 10,000 kilometers

• INFLATION PRESSURE

- Control your tire pressure every 15 days.
- Use manufacturer's recommended pressure
 Check the status of valves.
- Place caps on the valves.
- Theo caps of the varies.

DRIVING RECOMMENDATION

- The elements that impact negatively on the life of tires are:
- Driving at high speed.
- · Taking turns too fast.
- · Quick stops.

WEAR INDICATORS Driving with tires whose tread is below the manufacturer wear indicators is dangerous (below 1.66mm). This causes: Instability · Skids & loss of control.
